Artist Statement

Zearo's work takes on an autobiographical perspective to explore the relationship and entanglement between same-sex figures. Influenced by his South-East Asian background, he centers on lived experience by exploring ideas of longing, desire, memory, male gaze, masculinity, and Southeast Asian aesthetic through the medium of oil paint and most recently pastels and pigments. Through this direction, he attempts to create a space where same-sex stories are visible and approachable, a space where the tension of care and secrecy are being represented.
